Prepare for Sunday, November 13: Read Luke 21:5-19. What do we do with these words from Jesus? Truthfully, our lives are not the same as those who lived when Luke was writing, and the resistance we might encounter to our faith is not the same as some Christians elsewhere in the world. Yet we know that faith calls for us to lay down our lives; even if we aren't asked to do so all at once. Our predecessors clung to their hope, no matter what. It may be rare for us to face martyrdom, yet the witness we bring still runs counter to the brokenness of the world. Where do you see brokenness? What is our ultimate hope? How do we (as Christians) make connections between the two? It will not be easy, but as we have witnesses, it is ultimately worth whatever suffering come our way.
